Introduction

Alert Notes list problems that you need to be aware of before installing or using this software. Site Implementation Issues

- There is an error in the calculation of the field RANGSPR in the table CGRADE. This field contains the percentage difference between the salary grade minimum and the salary grade maximum. The calculation incorrectly bases the percentage on the salary grade maximum. It should be based on the salary grade minimum. The correct program for this table is available by contacting Technical Support.
- When a user opens an MDDB, HR Vision Software tries to verify that the user has proper security access to all class and analysis dimensions in the MDDB. If a public MDDB contains an analysis dimension to which the user does not have access, that particular MDDB will not display. Although it is correct for HR Vision Software not to display the MDDB, there is no dialog presented to the user indicating why he/she cannot view the MDDB and several messages will be written to the LOG window indicating that there is a program halt. HR Vision Software will continue to function and these messages do not need to be reported to the HR Vision Site Administrator or Technical Support.
- HR Vision Software, Release 2.01 contains fixes for the above **Site Implementation Issues**, plus several additional concerns. HR Vision Software, Release 2.01 is available on SAS Institute's Web site. The Web site is located at <http://www.sas.com/download>.
