

Installing HR Vision™ Software, Version 2.0 for Windows®

The HR Vision Software CD-ROM is AutoPlay-enabled. If your system is AutoPlay-enabled, Setup is launched automatically when you insert your HR Vision Software CD-ROM. If your system is not AutoPlay-enabled, then launch the `SETUP . EXE` program located in the root directory of the HR Vision Software CD-ROM. If you are not installing directly from the HR Vision Software CD-ROM, then launch the `SETUP . EXE` program from the appropriate directory containing the HR Vision Software installation files.

An Install Wizard will guide you through the installation process. The installation process is designed to be simple. On most screens, all you need to do is select the `Next` or `Yes` button to advance to the next screen.

To install HR Vision Software on Windows 95 or Windows NT, complete the following steps.

1. Determine where HR Vision Software will be installed. In most cases, both the default installation directory and program folder are appropriate.
2. Determine the directory location containing information about the HR Vision data warehouse. In most cases, you will need to specify a directory location on your site's network. Your site administrator can provide you with this directory location.
3. Determine the type of installation. You can choose one of the following two types:

Typical Installs the recommended installation of HR Vision Software.

Extended If your site has made extensions to the standard HR Vision functionality, you may need the `Extended` install. If you are not sure, check with your site administrator.

4. If appropriate, insert the CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive.
5. If necessary, launch the `SETUP . EXE` program from the CD-ROM or the appropriate directory.
6. As each window appears, fill in the appropriate information from steps 1 through 3 above. Select the `Next` or `Yes` button to advance to the next window.
7. To launch HR Vision Software at the end of the installation, select the check box `Launch HR Vision`. See your HR Vision Site Administrator for your login user ID and password.
