

# Applying the SETINIT for SAS/C<sup>®</sup> Cross-Platform Software for Windows<sup>®</sup> Environments

This document includes instructions for updating your SETINIT information for the following products:

SAS/C Cross-Platform Compiler  
SAS/C Cross-Platform C++ Development System

In order to run each software product that you license from SAS Institute, you must apply the SETINIT information. The SETINIT information contains current information about your licensing agreement with the Institute. Software from SAS Institute will not run without up-to-date SETINIT information. You must update your SETINIT information whenever you renew your license or add new products.

Any change requests for your license parameters may either be called in or submitted in writing on your company's official stationery to our Customer Service Department.

**Note:** Only the authorized SAS representative should change the SETINIT information. You designated the SAS representative when you licensed SAS/C Cross-Platform software.

## SAS/C Cross-Platform Compiler Product License Maintenance

The license information for SAS/C Cross-Platform Compiler is contained within a binary license data file, `sascc_set.dat`, provided on the installation media. You can use the `dset` utility to display the `sascc_set.dat` file. The `dset` utility is described in "Utility Command Formats" in the *Installation Instructions for the SAS/C Cross-Platform Software for Windows NT and Windows 95 Environments* and is on the installation media. The information used to update the license is known as the SETINIT zap file. A copy of the SETINIT zap file used for your site is also provided as one of the files on the installation media. It is named `sascc_set.zap`. This zap file contains data that corresponds to the data that was used to individually license your copy of the product before shipment.

When you renew your license, you will be provided with a new `sascc_set.zap` file. Update the license information by running the `zap` utility provided on the installation media and described in "Utility Command Formats" in the installation instructions. To update the license in the SAS/C Cross-Platform Compiler, enter the following command:

```
zap sascc_set.zap sascc_set.dat
```

The zap utility modifies the `sascc_set.dat` file, which is your binary license data file.

## **SAS/C Cross-Platform C++ Development System Product License Maintenance**

The license information for SAS/C Cross-Platform C++ Development System software is contained within a binary license data file, `sascd_set.dat`, provided on the installation media. You can use the `dset` utility to display the `sascd_set.dat` file. The `dset` utility is described in "Utility Command Formats" in the *Installation Instructions for the SAS/C Cross-Platform Software for Windows NT and Windows 95 Environments* and is on the installation media. The information used to update the license is known as the SETINIT zap file. A copy of the SETINIT zap file used for your site is also provided as one of the files on the installation media. It is named `sascd_set.zap`. This zap file contains data that corresponds to the data that was used to individually license your copy of the product before shipment.

When you renew your license, you will be provided with a new `sascd_set.zap` file. Update the license information by running the zap utility provided on the installation media and described in "Utility Command Formats" in the installation instructions. To update the license in the SAS/C Cross-Platform C++ Development System software, enter the following command:

```
zap sascd_set.zap sascd_set.dat
```

The zap utility modifies the `sascd_set.dat` file, which is your binary license data file.
