

# Installation Instructions

## **Risk Dimensions<sup>TM</sup> Analyst and Enterprise Editions Release 3.1 AIX/6000<sup>®</sup>, Compaq Tru64<sup>TM</sup> UNIX<sup>®</sup>, Solaris<sup>®</sup>**

### **Pre-Installation Checklist for Risk Dimensions Software**

Before you begin installing Risk Dimensions software, complete the following:

- Review all the items in your product package to make sure they are appropriate for your site.
- Read the **Alert Notes** provided in your product package. These **Alert Notes** contain any last minute corrections or additions to the installation document.
- Review the Risk Dimensions **System Requirements** provided in your product package. This document lists the requirements for installing and running Risk Dimensions software.
- Make sure your system is backed-up properly.
- Set your \$DISPLAY environment variable to an appropriate value.
- Follow the installation instructions in the **Installation Instructions and System Administrator's Guide for Release 8.1 (TS1M0) of the SAS System under UNIX Environments**.

### **Post-Installation Setup for Risk Dimensions Software**

After the Risk Dimensions software is copied to disk, a post-processing job is run to create the Risk Dimensions sample environment. This post-processing job takes a few moments to complete.

Before installing Risk Dimensions software, please set your \$DISPLAY environment variable. The post-processing job that is run to create the Risk Dimension sample environment needs this environment variable set to complete the installation.

## For AIX/6000, Compaq Tru64 UNIX, and Solaris

The syntax for setting your `$DISPLAY` environment variable is the following:

- For Bourne and Korn Shells:

```
export DISPLAY=hostname:0  
  
or  
  
export DISPLAY=ipaddress:0
```

- For C Shell:

```
setenv DISPLAY hostname:0  
  
or  
  
setenv DISPLAY ipaddress:0
```

## Starting the Risk Dimensions Application

A UNIX script file called `sasrisk` is located in the directory where you installed Risk Dimensions software. Append the installed directory name to your system `PATH` environment variable and use `sasrisk` to start up the Risk Dimensions software.
