SAS recommends that you perform two searches - one in which “component” is *Installation Issues* and one in which “component” is *General System Issues*.

In addition, you may want to perform a third search in which “component” is *All Components* and select a product to view product-specific Alert Notes.

- The SAS Data Quality - Cleanse product is driven by a collection of files known as the Quality Knowledge Base (QKB). The Quality Knowledge Base defines rules, criteria, and data by which data cleansing can be performed.

The SAS System 9 installation media contains a Quality Knowledge Base that supports the ENUSA locale (English, United States) as part of the SAS Data Quality - Cleanse product, and the DEDEU locale (German, Germany) as part of the SAS Data Quality - Cleanse, International Edition product. This Quality Knowledge Base is "beta" quality and is now obsolete.
