If You Install the Integration Technologies Client

Configuring the 64-bit version of the SAS System as a COM Server is a manual process. To set up a 64-bit installation of the SAS System as an IOM/COM server (such as with the SAS/Integration Technologies product), the following steps are required to configure SAS as a server under COM:

1. Install the Integration Technologies client on the server machine. To do this, go to the SAS Demos and Downloads page on the SAS Website;

Click on the SAS Integration Technologies link then the SAS Integration Technologies Client Applications link.

Download and install the Windows Client Development Component (Inttech.exe)

2. At a command prompt, change the current directory to the location of sas.exe in the 64-bit SAS System installation.

3. Enter the following command:

```
regedit core\sasinst\inttechc.reg
```

4. Select Yes to add the information to the registry.

5. Enter the following command:

```
sas.exe /regserver
```

SAS Note SN-008234 documents this problem.
