An error like the following is written in the SAS log for each lookup list: ERROR: "lookup-list-name" is not a recognized OSE lookup list in multi-org "A" Some rule code might also generate syntax errors like this one: ERROR 22-322: Syntax error, expecting one of the following: a name, a quoted string, a numeric constant, a datetime constant, a missing The syntax errors prevent the scoring engine from starting properly. Business Impact: The scoring engines might not restart after a new rule file is deployed.	After you apply this hot fix, the scoring engines start successfully after new rules are deployed.
