

Software License Renewal Instructions

SAS® Data Loader for Hadoop (Release 2.3 and Earlier) Basic Deployment

Renewing SAS® Software

The SAS System is licensed on a periodic basis. The SAS Installation Representative will receive new license information whenever your existing SAS System license is renewed. The license information you receive is in the form of the SAS installation data file (SID file), which includes your setinit.

SAS Data Loader for Hadoop Software

During installation, your installer entered the SID file which contained the license for the SAS Data Loader for Hadoop software. You must apply the SAS installation data file (SID file) to each vApp instance to renew your software.

The SID file is attached to the Software Order E-mail that your SAS Installation Representative received from SAS. The process of entering the SID file during installation is described in the topic "Final Configuration" in the *SAS Data Loader for Hadoop: Installation and Configuration Guide*.

Expiration Messages

On the day of the expiration of your SID file, you will begin to receive the following message each time you open SAS Data Loader for Hadoop:

```
SETINIT Expiration  
Your SETINIT for this product is nearing expiration.
```

After the expiration date, the message states that your setinit has expired.

When you begin to receive the expiration messages, you should contact your SAS Installation Representative to obtain your renewal SID file. When your SAS Software license is renewed, your SAS Installation Representative will receive a Renewal Order E-mail that contains a renewal SID file.

Renewing Your License

To renew your license and apply your new SID file to your existing installation of SAS Data Loader for Hadoop, follow these steps:

1. Save the SID file from your Renewal Order E-mail to a directory on the computer that hosts the vApp.
2. If necessary, start the VMware Player and play the SAS Data Loader for Hadoop virtual machine. Open the SAS Information Center by entering the web address that is displayed in the VMware Player window into a web browser.

3. If the vApp is already running (when a VMware Player window is available), and if SAS Data Loader for Hadoop is currently open in a web browser, follow these steps:
 - A. Make sure all running jobs have finished, and then save changes in SAS Data Loader for Hadoop. (Changes to settings will restart SAS services.)
 - B. If necessary, open the SAS Information Center by entering the web address that is displayed in the VMware Player window into a web browser.
4. In the SAS Information Center, click the **Settings** icon in the top right corner.
5. In the Settings window, select **Apply new license**.
6. Click **Browse** to select a new SAS Data Loader for Hadoop license.
7. In your file browser, navigate to the directory that contains the SID file, select the SID file, and click **Open**.
8. In the Settings window, click **OK**.
9. To begin using the new SID file, simply open SAS Data Loader for Hadoop in a web browser.

You have now renewed your license for SAS Data Loader for Hadoop. The new license will remain valid for renewal period designated in your renewal order e-mail.

Emergency Setinits

For emergency situations, you can download a temporary SID file that will extend the use of your licensed SAS software products for six days. To begin, visit SAS Install Center, <http://support.sas.com/documentation/installcenter/index.html>.

Under **Site and Account Data** on the right side of the page, select **Request a Temporary License Extension**. You may also select **Resend the SAS Installation Data**.
