Change Data Capture and the Benefits to the Modern Enterprise Data Warehouse

ABSTRACT

Historically, organizations built a data warehouse that was updated on a yearly, monthly, or weekly basis. Today in the current business environment, decisions by frontline business users need to be based on information that is refreshed hourly, every minute, or even every second. This session investigates how the data warehouse has evolved from being a departmental reporting solution to a central repository of information that is key to active decision making for front-line users. Underpinning this change is the evolution of the data integration technology that incorporates both batch and real-time technologies, this session covers the new features in SAS® Enterprise Data Integration 4.2 and how it supports the real-time enterprise.
