**ABSTRACT**

No matter how sophisticated your analysis and reporting solution may be you will still get the question “Can I have that in EXCEL?”. Regardless of how and where the enterprise intelligence computing goes on, the suite of Office products needs to be able integrate with this enterprise intelligence, or the time and energy you spend on ensuring data quality can be quickly lost with a sloppy cut and paste into EXCEL or WORD. With the release of v8, SAS introduced Integration Technologies, allowing SAS® to talk directly with the Microsoft Office suite.
