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SAS Training for STD Grantees

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ABSTRACT

The efficient and effective use of STD surveillance data for programmatic decision-making is critical to state and local STD programs. SAS software is well-suited to help realize this goal and is available from CDC at no-cost to state and local STD grantees. The Division of STD Prevention at CDC has developed a SAS training course for STD grantees, SASSI, to help meet this need. To make the training useful to users at all levels of experience, each module is designed to stand alone. Realistic data and real-world examples are used to help ensure relevance to the target audience and state and local STD program staff were engaged at all phases of development.
