SES data problem caused by fresh install

SAS FM 4.1 and SPM 2.1 install issue

Issue:

There is an issue with the data in the audit table from a fresh FM 4.1 or SPM 2.1 install. The has_audit_entries column in the audit table is being populated with NULL values during the course of loading the source dimension. NULL is not an acceptable value for this column.

After the installation has been completed, an alter script will need to be executed.

How to fix:

- Once the installation has completed, copy the install_data_fix.sql to your server.
- Open a command line and go to the location where the file was placed on your server, execute the following command:

➤ `mysql -usqladmin -pAdminAdmin1 -P3306 < install_data_fix.sql`

The location does not matter, if the mysql path is defined in the PATH system environment variable.

Post .1 issues:
