Background:

- Data Upgrade scripts were written for common, SPM and FM..

Issue:

FM tables required in order for the Upgrade scripts to run cleanly. A new script has been written to add the empty FM tables and the 4.0_to_4.1_alter_script.sql has been updated.

How to fix:

During the Installation, Insert the following instructions in the Upgrade Guide, Data Tier Installation, MySQL section.

1. Before running the `sqlupdate.bat` in the `\Program Files\SAS\SASSolutionsServices\1.1\DataTier\Update\Config\mysql`, run the `create402.sql` included with this SASNote.

For example, in a dos prompt:

```
mysql -usqladmin -pAdminAdmin1 -P3306 sassdm <create402.sql
```

2. The SPM only version of the 4.0_to_4.1 alter script, included with this SAS Note, will need to be placed in the following folder, replacing the prior version:

```
\Program Files\SAS\SASSolutionsServices\1.1\DataTier\Update\Config\mysql
```

This, also, will need to be done prior to running `sqlupdate.bat`.

Post .1 issues:

The Solutions, FM and SPM migration files will be kept entirely separate, thus avoiding this situation in future releases.
