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ASBATCH Utility

You can use the new ASBATCH utility to maintain definitions of users, groups, domains, logins, and shared logins. You can execute the scripts during off-peak periods to minimize interruptions of service. The ASBATCH utility is delivered in the Federation Server Client 3.1 package. New Memory Configuration Option

You can now use the new MEMSIZE configuration option to specify the total amount of memory that will be made available for use by the Authentication Server. The option has no default value, which allows the Authentication Server to use only as much memory as it needs for each request.
