

Software License Renewal Instructions

Licensing SAS® Event Stream Processing (ESP) Products

Renewing SAS® Software

SAS Event Stream Processing licenses are SAS installation data files (SID files) that contain the prefix ESP_ and are found in the sid_files directory of the SAS Software Depot or media. Copy the SID file or files to a permanent location that can be accessed from the program installation location.

Licensing in Microsoft Windows Operating Environments

By default, any application using SAS Event Stream Processing will look for a license in the etc\license directory of the ESP root install location. The root install location is commonly located here:

```
C:\Program Files\SASHome\SASEventStreamProcessingEngine\<release>
```

Copy the SID file to the etc\license directory in the ESP root install location.

If an application changed the license location using the C++ Modeling API `dfESPLibrary::Initialize`, copy the SID file to this location.

Licensing in UNIX Operating Environments

By default, any application using SAS Event Stream Processing will look for a license in the etc/license directory of the ESP root install location. The root install location is commonly located here:

```
!SASROOT/SASEventStreamProcessingEngine/<release>
```

Copy the SID file to the etc/license directory in the ESP root install location.

If an application changed the license location using the C++ Modeling API `dfESPLibrary::Initialize`, copy the SID file to this location.
