# Exporting SAS/GRAPH® Output for Inclusion in Web Pages and Other Software Applications

## ABSTRACT

When you execute SAS/GRAPH® code interactively, you typically view the picture on a display monitor through the GRAPH window. From the GRAPH window, you can export an image to a file that can be imported into other software applications or viewed through interfaces such as a Web browser. However, when there are multiple images to export, this may not be an efficient process. Instead, you can create the image files through the SAS/GRAPH program itself.

This paper describes the basic techniques to create image files using SAS®9. The image types covered include EMF, CGM, EPS, GIF, PNG, ActiveX, and PostScript. Methods for inserting images into Web pages and software applications such as Microsoft Office also are illustrated.
