Building Web Applications with Version 8 SAS/IntrNet™ Application Dispatcher

ABSTRACT

This paper presents techniques for building Web applications with the SAS/IntrNet™ Application Dispatcher. The Application Dispatcher is a SAS System server that allows developers to create SAS programs that may be executed by anyone with a Web browser. A brief overview of the Application Dispatcher is followed by a description of the components of a typical Web application. Several example programs are provided to demonstrate features of the SAS® System that may be used in Web applications. Examples show the use of the Version 8 Output Delivery System (ODS) to generate HTML and graphical output for the Web. New features of the Version 8 Application Dispatcher including sessions and host authenticated security are highlighted. It is hoped that this paper will provide both a guide to writing Application Dispatcher applications as well as an introduction to new Version 8 features of the Application Dispatcher.
