



## SAS® University Edition: QuickStart Guide for Amazon Web Services Marketplace

These instructions are for using SAS University Edition from Amazon Web Services (AWS) Marketplace.

### Step 1: Sign in to your AWS Marketplace account.

To sign in, open the [AWS Marketplace](#) and click **Sign in**. If you are new to AWS, create an account.

**Note:** When creating an account, you must provide credit card information to cover any AWS charges. SAS University Edition has no cost and is eligible for the [AWS free tier](#).

### Step 2: Open the SAS University Edition page.

In the AWS Marketplace, open the page for [SAS University Edition](#). Click **Continue to Subscribe**. Then click **Accept Terms** to complete your subscription.

### Step 3: Add SAS University Edition to your list of software subscriptions.

- Click **Continue to Configuration**. On the Configure this software page, accept all the defaults settings.
- Click **Continue to Launch**. The Launch this software page appears.
- From the **EC2 Instance Type** drop-down list, accept the default value of t2.micro, which qualifies for the free tier for one year. If you select a different instance, you might incur AWS charges.
- Under the **Key Pair Settings** heading, create a Key Pair, if you have not already.
- Click **Launch**. A message appears after AWS successfully deploys the software.

### Step 4: Start SAS University Edition.

After deployment completes, your subscription appears on the [Your Software Subscriptions](#) page.

- Click **View Instances**. The Instances Detail window appears.
- Copy the instance ID for SAS University Edition. An example of an instance ID is `i-d0w7a63b`.
- Click **Access Software** for that instance of SAS University Edition. The instance must be running for you to access the software.
- When prompted, enter `sasdemo` as the user name and paste the instance ID for SAS University Edition as the password.
- When the SAS University Edition: Information Center opens, click **Start SAS Studio**.

### Step 5: Stopping or Terminating the SAS University Edition instance.

You manage your SAS University Edition instance from the AWS Console. To open this console, click **View Instances** on [Your Software Subscriptions](#) page. The Instances Detail window appears.

- To open the AWS console, click **Manage in AWS Console**.
- From the console, select **Actions > Instance State**.
  - Select **Stop** to save the current instance but stop it from running. When prompted, click **Yes, Stop**.
  - Select **Terminate** to delete the instance. No uploaded data persists. When prompted, click **Yes, Terminate**.



### Step 6: Restarting SAS University Edition.

To restart a stopped instance of the SAS University Edition, select **Actions** > **Instance State** > **Start** from the AWS console.

To restart SAS University Edition if you terminated an instance, open [Your Software Subscriptions](#) page. Click **Launch more software**. On Configure this software page, accept the default values and click **Continue to Launch**.
